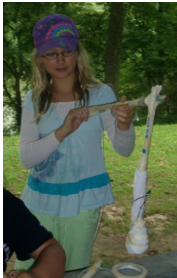

Science Camp: Wind, Sun, and Nature

The 2011 4-H Day Camp program is specially designed for youth ages nine to thirteen that are interested in science. This year's theme is *Wind, Sun and Nature*. Each day is filled with fun hands-on learning allowing your child to experience educational, science-related activities. The 4-H Science program teaches youth science principles and about 4-H.

This year science camp will focus on the power of the wind and sun in addition to nature. Youth will enjoy windmills, solar heating experiments, and scientific finds in our natural surroundings.



Every day begins with songs, the United States and the 4-H pledges as all youth meet and greet each other at the Riverside Pavilion. Several hands-on learning activities and a snack complete the morning.

After a healthy lunch, youth will continue to enjoy age appropriate science and outdoor activities. After 2:00 pm, it is off to the sparkling Coonskin Pool for an afternoon swim to play with friends made during the day.
